Low table attributed to Michel Zadounaïsky in gilded patinated wrought iron enclosing a rectangular travertine top on a corner base with curved legs finished with small slightly overhanging glides and joined by a brace X-shaped base with central connecting ring. Height 37,5cm. Long 84.5cm. Dep 43 cm. A wrought-iron table model featuring legs similar to this model is reproduced on a drawing preserved in the Lyon departmental and metropolitan archives (Michel Zadounaïsky fund)
