Studied at the École des Beaux-Arts de Marseille, where in 1880 he won first prizes in first prizes in painting and drawing, and the following year the Prix Jules Cantini prize. He continued his artistic training at the Académie exhibited at the Salon des artistes français, of which he became a member, and at the Salon d'Automne in Paris. mainly in landscape and portraiture. his talent. He painted the landscapes of his native Provence. He excelled in works with joyful scenes, round women, nymphs or legendary figures, reminiscent of
