### Description

"Portrait of a Young Woman," a beautiful oil painting on canvas signed in the lower right corner by the artist Hélène Le Roy d'Etiolles. The beauty of the young woman portrayed is striking, with blue eyes that seem transparent and a lovely face illuminated by a sweet smile. The artist depicts her against a backdrop of a blue sky, with her hair pulled back. It has a gilded frame with a mat. Hélène Le Roy d'Étiolles, born Devy in London on June 10, 1864, to French parents and died in 1939, was a French painter. A student of Jean-Joseph Benjamin-Constant, Hélène Le Roy d'Étiolles exhibited at the Salon des Artistes Français from 1888 to 1933. Her preferred subjects were women and young girls, whom she portrayed in soft, delicate colors. As one of the few female painters, her works can also be found
