Description

Oil on canvas depicting a painter working at his easel, in a living room furnished with an Empire sofa and walls adorned with paintings hung in the fashion of the early 19th century. Next to the painter, his cabinet containing his tubes of paint, his brushes...The floor of this room is parquet with a herringbone pattern, and, judging by the painter's clothes and hairstyle, we're in the 1820s - 1830s. The painting is in good condition. It has been cleaned, re-varnished and re-lacquered for its proper preservation. It only remains to find a frame. Paintings of interior scenes are always prized by enthusiasts as they provide a glimpse of the interiors of the period and the atmosphere that emanated from them, and this one is no exception to the rule.
