Narcisse Diaz de La Pena (1807-1876) Three Landscapes 3 drawings, 49 x 36 cm (16 x 22,8, 4 x 6,5, 13 x 16) Provenance: from an antique album of drawings belonging to a French collector from the late 19th century Of Spanish origin, Narcisse Diaz de la Pena is one of the most celebrated artists of the Barbizon School. His art was strongly influenced by Théodore Rousseau and brought him such success that he was able to live comfortably during the final years of his life. The subjects of his works often feature figures that reflect Oriental or Romantic themes, in which nymphs may inhabit his woodlands, but there is no doubt that he was primarily a landscape painter deeply connected to nature. His drawings are little more than concise sketches intended to commit the subjects to memory for execution with the
