The Maison Delvaux is one of the leading ones of the great Parisian names specializing in decorative arts, porcelain, porcelain and glassware, located at 18 rue Royale, in the 8<sup>e</sup> arrondissement of Paris, from the late XIX<sup>e</sup> century until the 1970s. Initially, it was a retail store selling porcelain, crystal, earthenware and decorative objects. Founded in the 1880s, the company sold products from prestigious such as Baccarat, Haviland, the manufactures of Sèvres, Choisy-le-Roi and Choisy-le-Roi and

Fontainebleau. From the 1920s onwards, the brand took a further step not only to resell objects, but to distribute creations under its own brand. A decoration workshop was set up in the store itself, staffed by decorators and artists specialized in glass and ceramics.

Delvaux's collaborators included Jean Mayodon , Charles Schneider, Clément Massier, Albert Dammouse... Unfortunately, we have not been able to identify the author or authors behind the "HUB LOY" signature.
