Description

A bronze sculpture with a dark patina depicting Diana the Huntress, a refined example of collectible small-scale bronze art associated with the Grand Tour phenomenon of the mid-19th century. The goddess of the hunt is depicted in a proud and dynamic pose. She wears a robe billowing in the wind, ideal for running and hunting in the woods. The classical iconography is rendered with extreme precision: the deity carries a quiver of arrows on her shoulder and holds a bow in her left hand. The flowing drapery and the finesse of the anatomical details attest to the quality of the casting and the great craftsmanship of the era. The work is enhanced by an elegant rectangular black marble base, which lends stability and geometric precision to the bronze figure. Condition as shown in photos I'm
