Widths of around 50 cm, slabs are available in lengths between 60 and 70 cm. We sell this limestone flooring at 360 EUR per Sq.m. We'll advise you on the best method of protection to apply after installation. Hot-applied beeswax applied after a water repellent adapted to this stone will give your floor the appearance of silky velvet. After rigorous installation, this paving requires no maintenance except regular washing with lukewarm water diluted with a little detergent. Diluted with Saint Marc detergent. Renewed waxing as required will ensure protection against the risk of oil and wine stains... The installation of a hot-water circulation heater by network in the ground under this catalytic surface is absolutely ideal. Provided you have the necessary reservation for its installation, this is one of the most comfortable and economical ways of heating. The mass - paving and its support - catalyses heat during the night at lower cost and delivers it during the day without the need for energy-hungry electrical supplements. The thicker the paving, the more heat it releases. In our opinion, with Burgundian paving and Italian Carrara marble, it's one of the most prestigious floors in our heritage.
