Art Deco mahogany and burl veneer bookcase, French work from the 1930s. This elegant cabinet features a curved front with rounded sides, opening with a central glass door framed by fluted uprights. The sides are decorated with oval panels in burl veneer, finely framed with geometric carved motifs typical of the Art Deco style. The cabinet rests on small tapered legs terminating in metal sabots, bringing lightness and refinement to the ensemble. The interior uncovers several shelves designed to display objects, glassware or trinkets. Very fine craftsmanship with a sober, elegant decor blending architectural lines and rich veneer.
