Large sculpted plaster medallion depicting Louis XVIII, King of France, surrounded by the rulers of the French monarchy from Clovis to the Bourbon dynasty. This remarkable work bears the names and portraits of numerous French kings, creating a striking historical tribute to the French royal lineage. The model is attributed to Louis Cordier (L. Cordier Inv.) and includes a dedication to the King's Bodyguards, reflecting its commemorative and political significance during the French Restoration period. With its impressive 61 cm (24 in.) diameter, this medallion is both an important historical artifact and a highly decorative display piece celebrating the return of the Bourbon monarchy in the early 19th century.
