Large solid bronze bell with original clapper and suspension brackets. Dated 1750, it features a marquis crown. The shield features an animal figure to the dexter and a chequered part to the sinister decorated with a bird. This coat of arms probably signifies the alliance of two important noble families. A pact that may have been materialized by the casting of this bell on the occasion of a memorable wedding ceremony in 1750. The bell is in very good condition, with no cracks, and gives a very pleasant sound. Weight approx. 35 kg.
