Large bronze of Hermes tying his sandals. Hermes or mercury appears in this fine bronze as a young man busy tying his sandals on a rock. This fine neoclassical bronze is of very fine quality and its patina is golden but slightly oxidized. The god has a superb face and he rests on a lightly worked granite block. There is a small lack of bronze at the tie of his garment. Perhaps he was carrying a quiver... as it dates from the first half of the XIXth century it is cast in several parts and one of the arms moves slightly. A very fine bronze of very fine quality with a superb neoclassical aesthetic, probably a souvenir of the grand tour. Dimensions: 33 cm high.
