Description

Bouffioulx stoneware pitcher vase by Roger Guérin, bearing the reference R 12 B and signed in intaglio by hand below the base. Glazed stoneware, predominantly blue, with medallion coat-of-arms decoration on the body 25 cm high, in very good condition. Roger Guérin was born in Jumet, Belgium, in 1896. From an early age, he showed a keen interest in ceramics and enrolled at the Université du Travail in Charleroi, where he took pottery classes with Willem Delsaux. Between 1915 and 1945, he created "grès salés grand feu" in a single firing (around 1300°). He also taught at the Institut Supérieur des Arts Décoratifs de la Cambre in Brussels from 1934 to 1939. Perfect in his creations, he sought out artistic collaborations and produced vases and sculptures for renowned artists such as Marcel
