soft, translucent green typical of this variety: a color that does not seek intensity but plays on substance and depth. The tsavorite garnets, with their clear, luminous green, form a contrasting cameo - two greens of opposing natures that complement each other without neutralizing each other. The basket is voluminous: the ring imposes itself on the finger. Its hemispherical curvature is comfortable, with no ridges or hooks.
