Description

Her business card mentions her name and title: "pittrice". Active in Florence in the 19th century, Giulia Cecchi painted several views of the Tuscan city. The inner courtyard of the Bargello features in several of her works. This palace courtyard, a magnificent example of medieval civil architecture, is surrounded on three sides by a peristyle with massive columns. On the right-hand side of the composition, a staircase leads to the loggia. Once a place of justice, the Bargello is now a national museum housing masterpieces from the collections of Italian Gothic and Renaissance sculpture, from Michelangelo to Cellini, and from Verrochio to Giambologna..
