#### Description

This scene depicts the shop of a Renaissance barber (late 15th, early 16th century), where a man has just bled an old man. His worried wife is at his bedside, two children a young barber looks on while shaving his customer, two mysterious men in the shadows chat. The light is placed on the center and right side of the scene, very much in vogue at the end of the 19th century. The format of this painting is quite unusual for Victor Chavet, a painter who likes to work in small. This is a prestigious work, presented at the 1894 Salon des Artistes Français as an "Hors Concours". The original frame still bears its cartouche: "Victor CHAVET - Hors Concours - Un Barbier Étuviste - XVème". Notice from the Salon booklet Artist :
