Large portrait of Emperor Franz I Stephan, oil on canvas, 18th century. Very fine oil on canvas painting in its original frame and most probably by Martin van Meytens . Martin van Meytens (June 24, 1695 - March 23, 1770) was a Swedish-Austrian painter who painted members of the Austrian royal court such as Marie-Antoinette, Maria Theresa of Austria, Emperor Francis I of the Holy Roman Empire, the emperor's family and members of the local aristocracy. His pictorial style inspired many other painters to paint in a similar format. Frans Stefan, known in the Southern Netherlands as Frans van Lorreinen, was Duke of Lorraine as Frans III Stefan from 1729 to 1737, Grand Duke of Tuscany as Frans II Stefan or Frans Stefan from 1737 to 1765 and Emperor of the Holy
