Description

Charming late 19th-century oil on canvas depicting two elegantly dressed young women in a lush park. One is seated in a garden armchair, holding a small dog in her arms, while her companion or friend, dressed in a sumptuous dress with red and blue highlights, seems to be engaging in conversation in a refined, poetic atmosphere. The composition is in the tradition of eighteenth-century-inspired scènes galantes, much appreciated by academic artists and genre painters in the second half of the nineteenth century. The vaporous treatment of the landscape, the effects of light filtering through the foliage and the richness of the fabrics clearly evoke the influence of Narcisse Virgilio Díaz de la Peña and the French Romantic school. The artist particularly highlights the shimmering costumes

and delicate faces, creating a scene imbued with softness and elegance. The warm palette and supple brushstrokes contribute to the decorative charm of this work. Today, the whole is in a satisfactory state of preservation and remains highly decorative. The canvas has been restored to its original condition.
