For sale: a pair of important Italian medals from the Kingdom of Naples and the Two Sicilies, produced during the reign of Ferdinand II of Bourbon. The first medal commemorates the inauguration of the electric telegraph, a work signed by Luigi Arnaud, dated 1852, Naples. The second medal is a tribute to Queen Maria Theresa of Austria, also created by Luigi Arnaud, dated 1858, Naples. These are two large-format examples of considerable historical interest, linked to 19th-century Neapolitan medal production and Bourbon patronage.
