Description

- A Roemer white wine glass in green cut and colored crystal, Tommy model, from the Saint-Louis crystal works located in the Münzthal valley in the Moselle département (57) in the Lorraine region.- The Saint-Louis manufacture is the oldest in France, and belongs to the Hermès group today.- From its star-shaped base to the dazzling reflections of the beveled diamond cuts, pearl nets, Tommy has been timeless since 1928, its elegant lines adorning the most refined table interiors.- This white wine glass in green-colored crystal bears the stamp of the Saint-Louis crystal glassworks.- This white wine glass in green-colored crystal is old and in good condition, it is possible to detect some small traces of use, this glass is handmade, which explains the small differences that can sometimes

be found (height, weight, patterns...).- These differences, far from being defects, make this white wine glass a unique object.- Appreciate them at the true value of the work carried out by the master glassmakers of the Saint-Louis crystal glassworks.- Reminder to buyers regarding the right of withdrawal for online sales via my Proantic shop.- Must be read before purchasing from my sales site hosted by Proantic.-- The right of withdrawal applies to sales made through my Proantic shop.- The withdrawal period is 14 days following the buyer's receipt of the item or goods.- The buyer must notify me via email or registered letter--without needing to provide a reason or justification--within the 14-day period prescribed by law, starting from the receipt of the parcel or goods.- The buyer has the right to change their mind and is entitled to a 14-day cooling-off period under this withdrawal law, and I respect this right.- Once this period has elapsed, the sale will be considered final and binding.- Return shipping costs (via postal service or carrier) are the buyer's responsibility in the event of withdrawal.- The buyer is required to return the goods or item within 14 days of receipt, in the same condition in which it was received--without breakage or damage--and in the original packaging, using the same shipping method and insurance coverage (matching the sale price on my Proantic shop) as originally arranged by the seller; the buyer must also email me the proof of posting/drop-off receipt issued by the postal service or the shipping slip issued by the carrier. - All sales made via my Proantic site are covered by insurance purchased from La Poste at the time of shipping; this covers loss or theft up to the purchase price paid by the buyer.- La Poste does not provide insurance against breakage or damage to the item or object; shipping coverage extends only to theft and loss.- Additional insurance covering breakage or damage--up to the price paid by the buyer on my Proantic site--is always purchased from the carrier when a third-party carrier is used.- The

buyer faces potential legal penalties if they fail to return the item or object within the 14-day timeframe or if it is not returned in good condition.- Refunds for the item or object will be issued within 14 days of the seller receiving the item or package and verifying the condition of the item or object.- If the item or object is found not to match its original condition at the time of dispatch, the sale will be considered final and non-refundable; the right of withdrawal will not apply.- Refunds for the item or object will be issued using the same payment method (check, bank transfer, PayPal) used by the buyer for the original purchase on my Proantic site.- If payment was made via PayPal, the buyer is responsible for initiating the refund process themselves--specifically by navigating to the "Dispute" section and opening a dispute case involving themselves, PayPal, and the seller. - This note regarding sales on my Proantic page is addressed to individuals who are litigious or acting in bad faith.- I advise such individuals against making any purchases on my Proantic page; this will prevent me from wasting time and money on legal proceedings.- Fortunately, my sales on Proantic generally go very smoothly, as my customers are typically pleasant, agreeable, and acting in good faith.- Sincerely,- Mr. Pineaud.
