certainly the Lizard trail, running along the  
seafront at Carry-le-Rouet.An artist accustomed  
to depicting scenes in Provence using the  
watercolor technique, Louis Montagné offers us  
here a rare, finely detailed view of  
Carry-le-Rouet. A pupil of Paul Saïn and  
Cormon, he entered the Salon des Artistes  
français in 1901, winning numerous awards in the  
process. He exhibited early on in Avignon with  
the merchants Kassler and Mouret, and during

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this period produced decorative panels in collaboration with the painter Paul Sain. Wounded in the First World War, he lost an eye. He was appointed director of the Ecole des Beaux-Arts d'Avignon from 1920 to 1928. Louis Agricola Montagné was a member of the Groupe des 13.
