Each torchère stands on an architecturally shaped wooden base adorned with carved shells and scrolling motifs, highlighted by a beautifully aged polychromy in soft green, ivory and dark brown tones. Rising from these sculptural bases, an exuberant arrangement of forged leaves, stems and curling tendrils creates a lively and highly decorative silhouette. The five light arms take the form of stylized flowers, their open petals serving as candle cups and reinforcing the organic character

of the design. The contrast between the aged wrought iron, the weathered painted surfaces and the subtle verdigris tones gives the ensemble remarkable visual depth and charm. The decorative vocabulary draws inspiration from the Rococo tradition, combining shell motifs, flowing curves and naturalistic forms in a distinctly Italian interpretation. Their generous proportions and sculptural presence make them striking decorative pieces, whether displayed in a classical, Mediterranean or eclectic interior. Italian work, 20th century. The wrought-iron tendrils seem to grow organically from the bases, while the aged green polychromy evokes the atmosphere of historic Italian gardens and antique architectural ornaments. Combining Rocaille-inspired carved shells with expressive floral ironwork, they possess a theatrical presence that transforms them into true illuminated sculptures. Their unusual scale and decorative impact allow them to structure and enrich an interior with remarkable ease.
