Large porcelain dinner service, exceptional in quality and number of pieces, from the famous manufacture Hache et Pépin Lehalleur in Vierzon and Paris, 19th century. White porcelain decorated with a double gilded fillet framing a parma-colored fillet. The handles and frêtelés of the serving pieces are gilded and embellished with elegant black palmettes and lambrequins. This service comprises 112 pieces. The name Hache Pépin-Lehalleur is synonymous with quality and prestige. In his report on the 1873 Vienna World's Fair, Victor Albert de Luynes wrote: "MM. Hache and Pépin-Lehalleur have represented with the most recent progress and with great perfection the manufacture of French hard porcelain".
