Description

A hand-painted Swedish chopping board for flax (SKÄKTETRÄ) made of wood, featuring floral patterns and a polychrome crown below the handle.

On the top part of the object, there are inscription s painted in red:

"ANNI.SOFFI.HANKANS 1847". This is the surname of Annia Soffia Hakkans, who received this decorative cutting board as a wedding gift. A wooden tool formerly used to scutch hemp or flax, as well as to separate the tow from the straw.

The worker who scutches holds a handful of flax in the left hand and pass it through the notch in the board, which is cut at an angle, then with a polished wooden knife called an "écangue" or "écang" that the worker hold in the right hand.
