Set of 4 Huaniao embroideries on silk
Traditional East Asian embroideries on the theme "Flowers and Birds"
These panels draw heavily on Chinese Cantonese export embroideries from the late Qing dynasty, or similar Japanese silk panels dating from the late 19th to mid-20th centuries
Each panel depicts a distinct seasonal scene combining specific species of birds, trees and flowers (such as plum blossoms, bamboo or chrysanthemums)
In Asian art, these combinations traditionally carry auspicious symbolic meanings, such as longevity, seasonal harmony and marital bliss.
They are presented in elegant gold-edged frames, with paper-covered mats that accentuate the elongated vertical format
