Small Vietnamese porcelain jarlet (porcelain stoneware) salvaged from the 15th century shipwreck off the coast of Hoi An (Vietnam). The wreck, excavated by archaeologists in 1997-98 gave rise to major sales by Butterfields in October and December 2000 in San Francisco and Los Angeles.
