Description

An elegant Charles X console table representing the finest Neapolitan cabinetmaking, crafted by Pietro Viola and dating from around 1830. The piece features a refined structure in maple wood, finely inlaid with amaranth wood in floral and scroll motifs that enhance the harmony of its lines. The yellow marble top lends brightness and prestige to the piece. A distinctive feature is the pair of front supports intertwined in a double scroll design, supported by carved and decorated bases, joined by a crossbar that ensures stability and aesthetic continuity. The rear supports, with a fluted rectangular section, complete the composition with understated elegance. The quality of the inlay and the refinement of the design attest to the mastery of Pietro Viola, one of the most highly regarded cabinetmakers of
