Description

Magnificent pair of small oval oils on paper. young women or Vestals. Restorations to be carried out. removal of the papers marouflaged on the Panels. as air bubbles have formed between the paper and the panels and one of the two has a small crack in the paper. NICOLAS BERNARD LÉPICIE was born in Paris in 1735 and died in the same city in 1784. He was a pupil of Carle Van Loo, approved by the Académie Royale, second prix de Rome. Often compared to Chardon and Greuze, his paintings were a great success in the 18th century. He is featured in numerous museums worldwide, including the Louvre including the Louvre, Hermitage Museum, Versailles (Trianon) etc. Marked in ink on the reverse of the panel "Lépicié pinxit 1780" it has been appraised and attributed by the René Millet
