An elegant 17th-century Tuscan frame in carved and gilded wood, featuring a refined decoration of stylized leaves along the inner edge and a finely crafted outer band with a dotted pattern and molded profiles. The frame features a typical 17th-century architectural design, with significant depth and a box profile, particularly suited for housing antique paintings on canvas or panel. As evident from an examination of the back structure, the frame was reduced in size at a later date to accommodate a smaller work. However, this alteration does not compromise its decorative charm or historical integrity. It retains a pleasing antique gilding with signs of use and wear consistent with its age.
