Description

This vase, typical of 20th-century decorative pieces, is distinguished by its bulging, curved silhouette, embellished with two scrolled handles inspired by neoclassical styles. Its relief decoration, depicting deer and oak trees, is in the tradition of naturalist and forest motifs, highly prized between the 1920s and 1960s. Made in fine earthenware or glazed stoneware, it features a midnight blue or black background that highlights the hand-painted motifs in natural tones (brown, green, beige). A border of raised pearls highlights the neckline, adding a touch of elegance to this piece. The interior, glazed in pale pink, is characteristic of decorative vases of this period. This type of vase, with its pastoral decorations, is representative of European manufactures (notably French or German)
