Ancient & elegant pomponne chatelaine set with orange-red carnelian cabochons. It features a large openwork motif holding several articulated chains. One of the elements is fitted as a seal, testifying to the dual utilitarian and decorative function of this accessory. The workmanship of the setting testifies to the skill of late 18th-century jewelers. The well-preserved cornelians offer a beautiful transparency when exposed to light. The reverse retains its antique fastening system. This chatelaine is an interesting testimony to fashion accessories of the Directoire period. Length: 18 cm. Good overall state of preservation with a patina of use in keeping with its age.
