Description

Beautiful original print by painter and etcher Henri Goetz, a major figure in the École de Paris and a key player in 20th-century abstraction. Born in New York and settled in France by the 1930s, Goetz frequented the great artists of his time and developed a personal body of work that combined poetry, freedom of gesture and technical research. This original color etching, signed in pencil lower right and numbered 44/50 lower left, perfectly illustrates his abstract universe. The composition combines organic forms, graphic lines and floating elements in a space that evokes the marine world, imaginary landscapes and the language of signs. The contrasts between greens, blues, blacks and ochres create a balanced, lively and particularly decorative work. Henri Goetz is also renowned for
