student of Corot, regularly exhibited at the Paris
Salon. The composition depicts a dappled grey
horse resting in a rustic stall, surrounded by hens
and a rooster pecking at the golden straw on the
ground. A saddle and harness hang from a
wooden post in the foreground, a picturesque

detail that anchors the scene in everyday peasant life. The stable's timber frame, rendered in warm shades of ochre and brown, is bathed in a soft, golden light characteristic of Defaux's style, inherited from the Barbizon school.
