They show only a few very slight traces of use, normal given their age. Ideal for a refined table, a goldsmith's collection or decorative use. Bouillet Bourdelle is a French goldsmith's house particularly renowned for its high-quality silver-plated and stainless steel productions. History The company was founded in Lyon at the end of the XIXe century by Henri Bouillet. In 1919, Laurent Bouillet joined forces with chiseler Bourdelle, giving birth to the Bouillet & Bourdelle brand. From 1924, the company moved to Villeurbanne, near Lyon, and

developed a major production of table and cutlery goldsmiths. It became the owner of the Cailar-Bayard cutlery factory and enjoyed great success during the Art Deco period. Reputation Bouillet Bourdelle is considered one of the important French silversmiths of the interwar period, with numerous Art Deco creations. The house notably made cutlery for the Concorde, which contributed to its fame.
