Object exceptional, an object of such rarity that museums or calligraphy circles museums or calligraphy circles to consider it a major discovery. It is a "salesman's sample book" (GEORGES W. HUGUES OF BIRMINGHAM). Leonardt & Co. & Co manufactured these monumental binders... the salesman presented his government departments, retail outlets and schools ... Feathers tied by a red thread, waited on a cardboard box with the reference number or the material. Each feather had its own shape (reservoir nibs, fine nibs for cartography, calligraphy nibs, softer "balloon" nibs), the metal (raw steel, blued steel, gold-plated) and, above all, flexibility. When unfolded, this "filing cabinet" is 4.25 meters long. It comprises 14 trays with blue velvet
