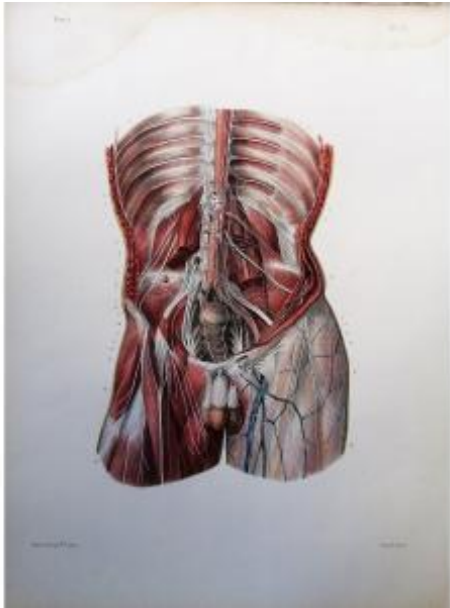

ORIGINAL LITHOGRAPH FROM THE "TRAITE COMPLET DE L' ANATOMIE DE L' HOMME" REALIZED BY DOCTOR BOURGERY AND DRAWN BY "NH JACOB" PUPIL OF THE PAINTER DAVID - THIS PLATE WAS REALIZED AROUND THE YEARS 1840 AND REPRESENTS AN ECORCHE OF THE LUMBAR AORTIC AND SACRAL PLEXUX "TOME 3 PLANCHE 55" - TO SIGNAL TRACES OF HUMIDITY IN THE TWO TOP COINS - VERY GOOD CONDITION FOR THE DRAWING -anatomical engraving from "Traité complet de l'Anatomie de l'Homme" by Dr. Bourgery and draftsman Jacob. This plate is authentic and dates from the 1840s and taken from the monumental work of Dr. Bourgery, who occupied the last 15 years of

his life to complete it. Unanimously recognized for the finesse of his drawings made by Professor draftsman anatomist Jacob, a pupil of the famous painter of the Revolution, David. This work is illustrated with 725 lithographed plates in sixteen volumes, eight volumes of text on 2108 pages, and eight volumes of plates for 3750 individual figures, which will be the subject of eighty issues staggered from 1831 to 1854, the last volume being published posthumously.
