- Six Roemer liqueur or port glasses in parma-colored cut crystal, Tommy model, from the Saint-Louis crystal glassworks located in the Münzthal valley in the Moselle department (57) in the Lorraine region.- The Saint-Louis manufacture is the oldest in France, belonging to the Hermès group today.- From the base of the star-shaped stem to the dazzling reflections of the diamond-cut bevels and pearl threads, Tommy has been timeless since 1928, its elegant lines adorning the most refined table interiors.- The six liqueur glasses in parma-colored crystal feature the stamp of the Saint-Louis crystal works beneath the round star-shaped stem.- These liqueur or port glasses in parma-colored crystal are old and in good condition, it is possible to detect some small traces of use, these glasses are
