The contoured apron features rich decoration with volutes, foliage, and ornamental motifs that are finely carved and engraved. At the center stands a large panel with a shell motif that lends the piece elegance and a strong decorative impact. The imposing, curved legs are connected by a shaped crossbar enriched with a prominent central element carved with foliage and scrolls, creating a harmonious whole of exceptional craftsmanship. The original Verde Alpi marble top perfectly follows the sinuous lines of the structure and further enhances the richness of the gilding. Given its size, construction quality, and striking
