Beautiful Strasbourg earthenware bottle bucket from workshop of Joseph Hannong, decorated in polychrome with an elegant floral motif known as "à la fleur Chatironnée." The finely executed decoration features large blooms blooming in shades of pink, purple, and blue, accompanied by delicate foliage on a slightly bluish-white background typical of Strasbourg production. Form is dynamic, with a curved rim, resting on a small foot, and featuring molded side handles accented with polychrome fillets. Mark painted in blue under base: Joseph Hannong's monogram, and 545. Large model: 19 cm x 24 cm. Condition: generally good considering its age. Note: two discreet flaws: a small chip on edge of the base, a slight crack on edge, which does not prevent the earthenware from "ringing" properly. Sought-after
