A Chinese porcelain dish decorated with a red peony--a symbol of ardent passion (for the king?)--surrounded by two eagles (a pair), symbols of strength and power, as well as a pair of red carp, symbols of abundance, strength, and perseverance;which can transform into dragons...This symbolism found on this dish intended for the French market is consistent with its attribution as a "Pompadour service," which it most likely was.Minor restoration of a chip and a small crack at 10 o'clock, with some enamel reinforcement.
