Description

An imposing chiseled bronze urn. The upper part is adorned with a dragon in the round, coiling around the neck of the vase amid swirling clouds. The body of the vase is covered with a relief depicting a scene of birds among the branches of a flowering plum tree (ume)--a motif symbolizing rebirth and longevity. In the lower section, two turtles (minogame) are depicted amidst the waves--a traditional symbol of happiness and long life. Japan, Meiji era (1868-1912). Bronze, relief casting, chiseled. Height: 53 cm, diameter: 28 cm. Condition: good, visible dent on the belly, slight scratches on the patina.
