Description

Large architectural cherub head made of terracotta. This putto head is made of kiln-fired terracotta. It features stylized curly hair, plump cheeks, and a smiling expression characteristic of Baroque-style putti or cherubs. It was likely designed to be installed outdoors, on a garden wall, a facade, or a fountain. The mottled gray, green, and orange surfaces are evidence of prolonged exposure to moisture and the elements. The localized gray-green crusts are mineral deposits or calcifications often left by hard water. There is no clear indication of its age, but certain signs of wear suggest that it is quite old. 30 cm wide, 28 cm deep, and 30 cm high. Total weight: 8.1 kg.
