Fragmentary terracotta bust head
Head of a man wearing a traditional wig, made of fired terracotta, featuring a natural patina in dark earthy tones
The curly wig was a common fashion statement among the European nobility and elite of the 18th century
12 cm wide, 10 cm deep, and 15 cm high
Total weight: 0.7 kg
Age-related wear, particularly on structural fragments along the neckline and at the base, where it was originally attached to a complete bust or a larger architectural relief
