Description

HAUTE EPOQUEA significant and rare Gothic-style bronze mortar, featuring a single, sturdy rectangular handle. Superb, uniform bronze patina, a glossy brown, evidence of its daily and prolonged use over centuries. Traces of wear and impact contribute to this incredible patina. *5 small triangular protrusions on the lower section, resembling the buttresses of an architectural tower*The body of the mortar has a concave cylindrical shape. *The rim of the mortar is highlighted by two thick moldings The mortar bears the date 1550 on its lower part. -While one might have expected this specific type to date closer to late 15th or early 16th century, this demonstrates that the use of these shapes persisted over time beyond periods traditionally considered.Dimensions17.5 cm high & 16.5 and
