### Description

White opaline glass vase with a blue spiral, likely Murano, circa 1950-1960. An elegant decorative vase made of blown glass, likely from the Murano workshops, dating from the 1950s-1960s. This piece immediately captivates with the purity of its lines and the elegance of its color contrast. The cylindrical body in satin-finished white opaline glass is delicately encircled by a spectacular spiral of cobalt blue glass, applied while hot using a technique characteristic of post-war Italian glassmaking. With a resolutely modernist design, this vase perfectly illustrates the refined aesthetic of Italian design from the 1950s and 1960s, a period during which the master glassmakers of Murano developed clean, minimalist forms that highlighted the material and color.
