Description

A patinated bronze clock depicting a lighthouse with architectural details: the body is adorned with windows and openings that mimic the masonry of a real lighthouse, while the upper section reproduces the lantern with its openwork gallery. The base is made of black marble. The upper part of the lighthouse featured a barometer, a thermometer (in degrees Celsius and Fahrenheit), and a clock face, and it rotated thanks to a complex mechanism. Signed Janetti Padre e Figli, Torino, Roma, Firenze: Janetti Padre e Figli was one of the most prestigious Italian retailers of luxury goods, decorative arts and antiques during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. Founded by the Janetti family in Turin and later expanded to Florence, Rome and Naples, the firm supplied an affluent
