The painting of the Cuzco School represents an exquisite syncretic synthesis, unique in viceregal art, a visual phenomenon that crystallized the profound Andean spirituality and the fervor of Catholicism brought by the Europeans. Born in Cuzco during the colonial period, this school is distinguished by its saints and Madonnas dressed in sumptuous garments adorned with the gold brocade (estofado) technique, reflecting the gold of the earth. These figures, with their hieratic faces and devout gestures, do not merely inhabit the Christian heavens but integrate with elements of Peruvian nature: their frames and backgrounds are populated by exotic birds and vibrant flowers of
