Description

Oil on canvas representing the entrance to a port overhung by a lock and towards which a small steamship is heading. In the distance, the silhouettes of port loading cranes are visible. Characters and a carriage also animate the composition. The landscape is treated with an impressionistic touch visible especially at the level of impasto highlighting certain details such as the smoke from the boat, the reflections of the twilight sky in the water,...Signed "Léon Goffart" in the lower right corner.Inscription "Léon Goffart" in a cartouche on the frame.Léon Goffart was a Belgian painter active at the turn of the 19th and 20th centuries, who was particularly noted for his landscapes.Good overall condition.Dated late 19th-early 20th century.Dimensions:Framed: 32.5 x 41 cmView:
