Hunting in Pictures by Max Haider, 1860. Max Haider (born July 21, 1807, in Biederstein, Schwabing, Munich; + June 21, 1873 in Munich) was a German hunter, animal illustrator, lithographer, and illustrator. The Munich artist Max Haider drew and painted a great many hunting scenes for the *Fliegende Blätter* and the *Münchener Bilderbogen*. His motifs fit very well into the cultural program of King Maximilian II, who, as a counterpoint to the classical-inspired world of his father Ludwig I, focused on the revival of regional and national art in order to awaken a sense of national identity among the Bavarians. The frames measure 30 x 37 cm. The prints are a true rarity! Inscribed: "Die Rehjagd II"
