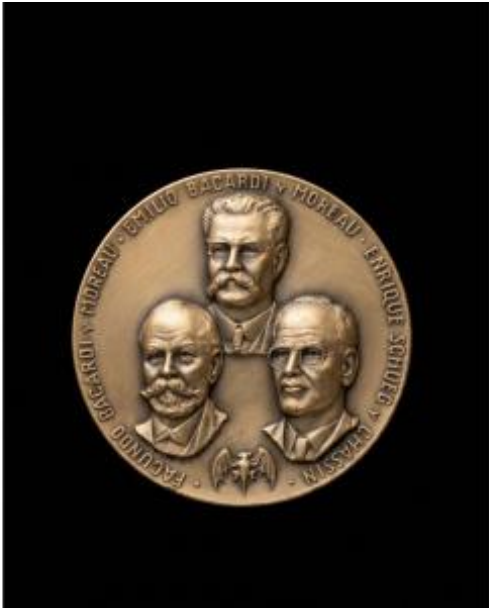

For the official inauguration of the company's international headquarters, the "Bacardi Building," in Hamilton, Bermuda, on May 26, 1972 147 g Obverse: The medal features sculpted profile portraits of the three historical figures and pioneering founders of the spirits brand: Facundo Bacardi, Emilio Bacardi y Moreau, and Enrique Schueg y Chassin. The bottom is adorned with the brand's first emblem. The work is signed in the metal by American sculptor Ralph J. Menconi. On the reverse: The piece bears the brand's symbol: the
